

The number of Green councillors have rapidly increased in the South East as people switch to voting Green for the first time. Greens also won a first seat in Hampshire at the 2021 Horndean Downs by-election, which saw local Green campaigner Blossom Gottlieb elected to East Hampshire District Council.

DAMAGING AQUIND CABLE “NOT QUITE DEAD,” SAYS TIM

“I WILL KEEP SPEAKING OUT AFTER AQUIND REQUEST JUDICIAL REVIEW.”

After the Business Secretary decided the project shouldn't go ahead, the company behind the Aquind electrical cable made an application for a judicial review of the decision. This means it could still go ahead which would be a disaster because the cable threatens our green spaces along eastern Portsmouth and could cause severe disruption.

Did you know that Aquind is owned by the Russian oligarchs Alexander Temerko and Victor Fedotov and that his company has made over

£1 million in donations to the Conservatives and even threatened to sue our Portsmouth North MP? Tim says, **“As the recent invasion of Ukraine has shown that the security risk of relying on potentially hostile dictatorships for our energy is too great. I will keep speaking out about this disastrous project and support the Stop Aquind campaign wholeheartedly. It MUST NOT go ahead here so I will do all I can to stop it.”**
