

## Your Spring Newsletter letting you know about Green Party activities around Portsmouth and in Central Southsea

**YOUR CONCERNS** During the last few weeks we have knocked on doors in Central Southsea to find out which issues residents are most concerned about. The problems which crop up again and again are **rubbish, parking, new housing developments and congestion**. These are all issues that require more than the current piecemeal approach by the City Council in order to deliver better policy and infrastructure that works throughout the city. The Council has not applied joined up thinking and preferred decisions that favour private outsourcing, which has not always served Portsmouth well.

**HOUSING** Sites are being developed for housing while we have empty homes and unused brownfield sites. We must stop building developments for people who commute to jobs elsewhere, and develop more affordable properties for small businesses and start-ups. New housing should be balanced with new employment sites.

**Ian McCulloch** has always pushed for a properly thought through City-wide parking strategy. He has talked to the University about their strategies to encourage students not to bring cars to the City. They now employ drone footage to illustrate to new students the congestion problems, as well as the bus infrastructure and walking/cycling routes in the city. Ian will work with them to help make travelling easier for students in and out of the city.

**Sustainability** is a vital factor in decisions made by local government, but is continually side-stepped in favour of short-term financial issues. Ian will demand that sustainability is taken into account when Council decisions are made, for example requiring all large developments and all public buildings to generate at least 10% of their own energy on site and constructing all seafront buildings to withstand current and future levels of flooding.

We pledge that our election campaign will be clean, honest and positive.
